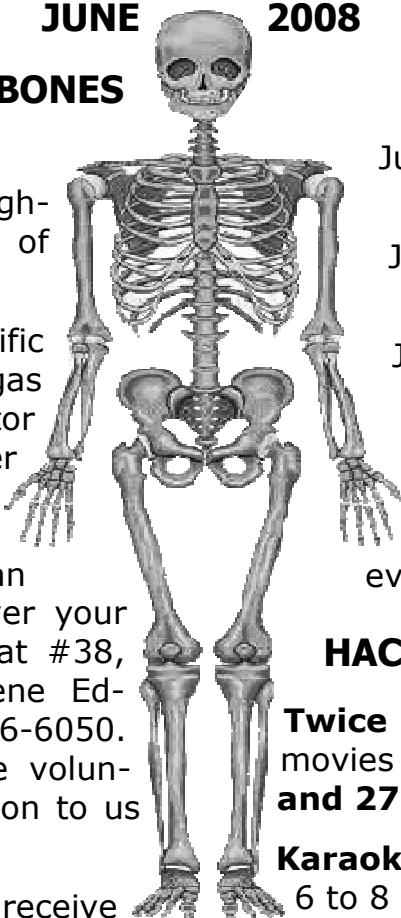

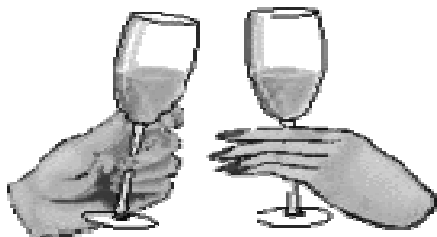

Please remember to sign up for pot-lucks and dinners if you plan to attend. With fewer people, it is even more important for the cooks to have an accurate count when they shop for food.

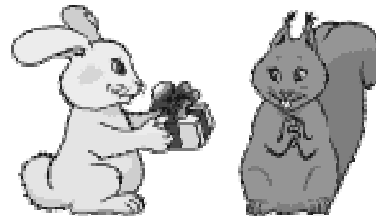
