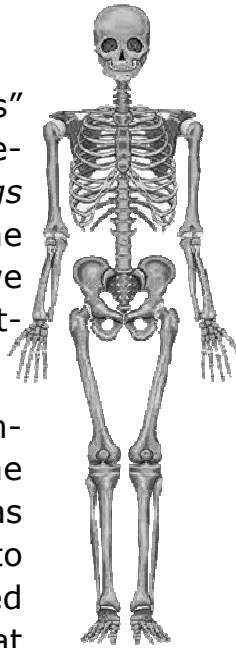
WE'RE BACK IN PRINT!

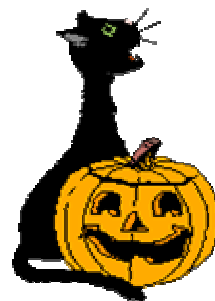

According to the Mesa Fire Department, BBQ's should always be 10 feet away from any structure when in use. They should also be used only in well ventilated areas and NOT UNDER YOUR PATIO OR CARPORT. Please check to see that you have tightly fitted connections and that the hoses are supple and not brittle.
